
## TRAVELER'S REST

Second, I wanted to find a way to make the state's CAR members personally involved in the project. We will be making and collecting quilts and fleece tie blankets to donate to the USO, and they will distribute them to passengers and families traveling through our 4 NC USO airport lounges. Members will have the opportunity to learn how to piece and quilt fabric, as well as designing patterns and choosing colors. Even the youngest members can help take part.
